COURSE DESCRIPTION



This course requires the student to demonstrate personal awareness of Work Health & Safety (WHS) legislative requirements, and the basic principles of risk management and prevention of injury and illness in the construction industry.

This White Card course covers the basic WHS knowledge required prior to commencing work tasks within any of the sectors of the construction industry. Course fee is \$89.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students must also be a current Western Australian resident.

YOUR ASSESSMENT



Students will be assessed during the classroom session. Assessment will confirm knowledge and skills have been acquired by students allowing them to demonstrate competency across the unit.

CERTIFICATE



Upon completion Students will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for CPCCWHS1001 Work safely in the construction industry.

In addition to the statement of attainment, the white card will be issued to the student at the completion of the course provided they are competent and the unique numbered white card will be registered with Worksafe Western Australia.
