

<u>10392NAT Course in Emergency Asthma Management – Course Description</u>

Course details	Due to the high number of asthma sufferers in Australia, specialised Asthma training was developed for the early childhood education industry. While asthma training is relevant to all industries, the new legislation for childcare industry specifies that a staff member with asthma specific training be onsite at all times, including Anaphylaxis and First Aid training. This course covers risk management of Asthma, including training for prevention, management, treatment and intervention. This unit applies to work in a wide range of settings where emergencies involving asthma attacks may occur, such as: Childcare Early education centres Schools Sports clubs and groups Aged care workers
Training program	Students must bring: ✓ Photo identification (licence or a passport) ✓ Pen and paper to make notes and complete assessment activities ✓ Comfortable clothing for practical activities which include scenarios involving people working on the ground There are 3 components to this program: 1. Theory training in the classroom 2. Practical training in the classroom 3. Assessment for both knowledge and skills The classroom session is a 4hr program including breaks.
Pre requisites Assessment	It is important to note that this course requires a level of physical ability to complete practical assessments. If your health or fitness restricts you from performing physical activities associated with this program, you will not be able to complete this course. This course combines plain English, videos, photos, and questioning to ensure all learners are able to have the best possible chance at comprehending the required knowledge and skills. Students will be assessed during the pre-study and classroom session. Assessment will confirm knowledge and skills have been achieved to demonstrate competency across the unit.
Certification	If a student is not successful in completing all assessments satisfactorily, they will need to rebook the course at the full course fee. Once a competent mark is awarded, learners will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for 10392NAT Course in Emergency Asthma Management issued by Surf Life Saving NSW (RTOID 90394).
