

PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT PHOTOGRAPH GUIDELINES

Please see below acceptable examples for photographs performing the work.

TRAFFIC CONTROLLER:

With your submission, we require one photo of:

- 1. Wearing correct PPE
- 2. Using the stop/slow bat in the correct hand
- 3. Using a two-way radio
- 4. Using hand signals





The Traffic Controller is in full PPE gear, you can see clear communication with the two-way-radio or through hand signals. The slow/stop bat is in the correct hand, hand signals are used properly. In the background you can see the ute/prior warning signs, as protection for the worker.

It is very important that a bit of the background is visible in order to identify the position of the Traffic Controller and the correct set up according to the TCP.



IMPLEMENT TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN:

With your submission, we require one photo of:

- 1. Yourself setting up the worksite placing signs and cones
- 2. Wearing correct PPE
- 3. Using the stop/slow bat in the correct hand (if completing Traffic Control course)
- 4. Any other photos to demonstrate your practical assessment requirements
