(Turn vehicle on and off, disable power to arrow board, disconnect electricity leads)

I can follow site plans and understand the symbols and information on them.

I can identify and act on safety breaches in the workplace.

I can select and wear appropriate P.P.E / P.P.C and maintain it to organisation requirements.

I keep work areas clean and safe from potential hazards

I can obtain the relevant permits and clearances for specialised work to be carried out.



I understand and follow safe manual handling practices.

I can identify and apply procedures relating to high-risk activities.

I can recognise alarms and can respond accordingly.

I can identify the responsibilities associated with emergencies.

I can apply basic firefighting principles.

I can identify emergency escape routes and procedures.

I can identify personal risks to my wellbeing and recognise preventative strategies.
